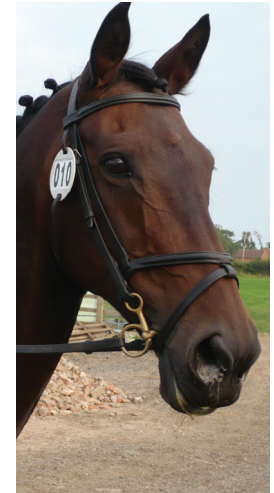

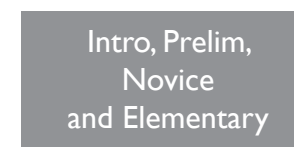

Competition Rules:

This competition is run in accordance with British Dressage Rules.

Correct dress must be worn for all classes. Riding hats to current PAS 015, EN 1384 or ASTM F1163 with either a Kite mark or S.E.I. MUST be worn at all times when mounted.

No galloping in the warm up area.

No stallions or colts except with prior permission.

Cars, lorries and trailers must be parked in the allocated car parks.

Horses and ponies are not to be left unattended unless correctly secured inside the trailer/horsebox. Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a short lead at all times.

Please clean up any waste.

Any competitor or anyone associated with a competitor who by word or act is abusive or discourteous to a judge, official or steward will be disqualified from the class.

All accidents must be immediately reported to the show organiser.

Persons participating in the competition or attending the centre do so at their own risk.

Disclaimer:

The organiser, any agent, employee or representative of Arena UK do not hold themselves responsible for any loss, damage or injury (including death) to competitors, onlookers, spectators, their property, horse or vehicle in connection with any event.
